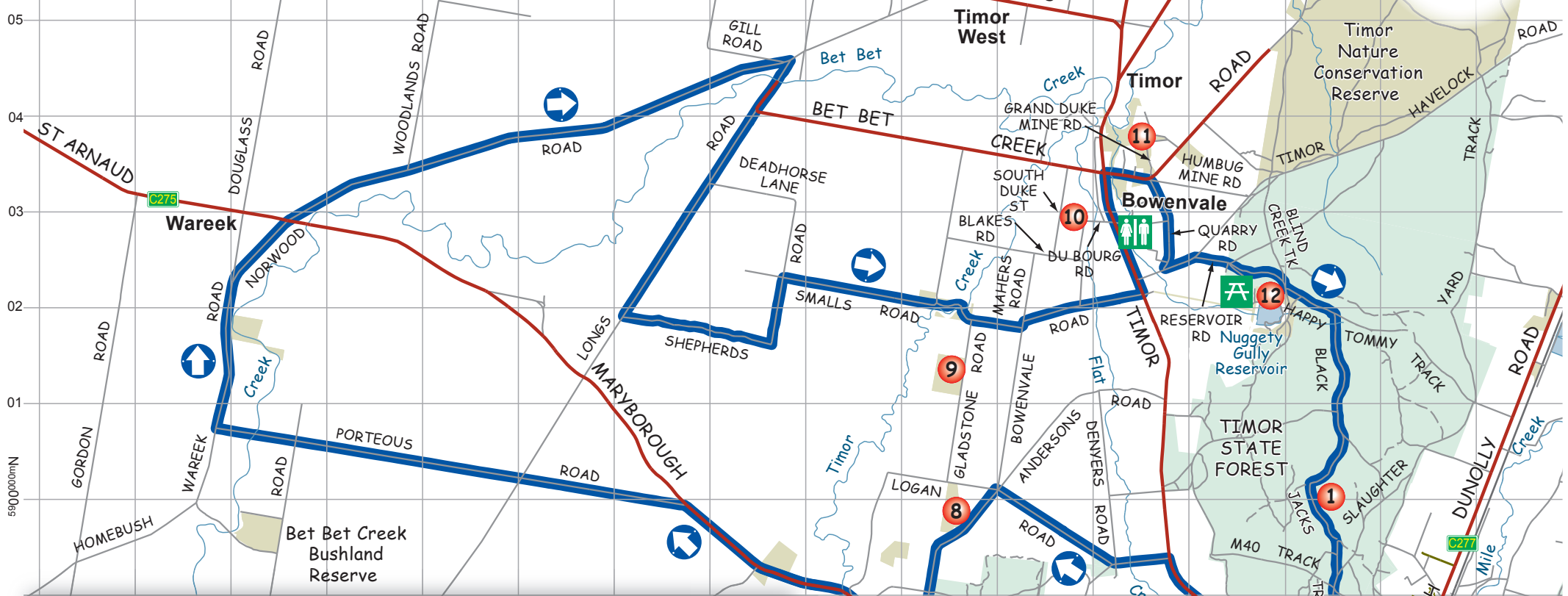


Timor Grand Duke Trail - 45km
